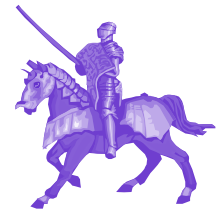

HOW TO PACK -- PARENTS, PLEASE READ & SIGN!

Clothing. Every young person is expected to wear clothes that are unquestionably modest and appropriate for a Christ-honoring activity. **Teen Girls:** shirts and tops must be high enough at the top (no cleavage), low enough at the bottom (no mid-ribs) and loose enough all over (not overly form revealing). **All girls:** No tank tops, please. No two-piece bathing suits. The longer style of walking shorts are acceptable, but regular shorts are not. Skirts or dresses are required for the evening services. Camp staff reserves the right to be the final judge on modesty and to require a change of clothing when necessary. **Guys:** jeans (or long shorts) are fine during the day, but non-jean slacks and collared shirts are needed for the evening services. Bathing suits must be trunk style.

Misc. Don't forget a sleeping bag or bedding, Bible, pen, notebook, and spending money for snacks and additional activities (paintball, ropes course, etc.) Things to leave at home: cell phones (they won't work) and all electronics.
